The piece should have **dynamic markings**, a tempo marking, articulations, and expressive elements. Everything is to be <u>typed</u> in the software.if it is for any type of choir/voice, it must have words (please make the syllables match the notes written... no 2-words-per-one-note please)

- -emailed composers bio/notes in .doc or .rtf format

NEW THIS 9-WEEKS:

- You will write a **1 page bio** of the composer (that's you) for your comp. (typed, double spaced, 12 pt font, 1 inch margins) This is NOT a farse! A REAL bio!
- You will write "composers notes" (min. one page in length, typed, double spaced, 12 pt font, 1 inch margins) that describes the composer's intent and/or feelings on the piece, the history/background/inspiration of the piece, why you wrote it, tonal areas, musical themes, anything of note, the golden proportion, etc. In other words, a scholarly paper about the work.

This assignment is worth 400 points (40% of your grade).
