

Sample Schedule with 2 Music classes every year.

This is only a sample schedule, and may need to be modified for your particular needs. Consult your high school guidance counselor.

This is different from the average student's schedule in 2 ways:

1. Most students take history in 9, 10, and 11th grade, but to get the 2 years of Foreign Language in, postpone your 11th grade history class until 12th grade.
2. Life Management Skills and personal fitness are usually taken together, but since personal fitness is offered Zero period, you can take it then, and combine LMS with PE instead.

**Life Management Skills (LMS) is also offered as an on-line class, and as a free adult-ed class, so you could take PE and Personal Fitness together and not have any zero-period classes.

**Drivers' Ed might be able to be worked into the first semester of the 10th grade year, but will probably require you to miss a semester of Jazz—talk to Mr. Bula.
