**Wed, December 22**

Arrival in Tallahassee should be mid afternoon. We'll call home when we're close. The  
bus will return to the front parking lot of Leon. Have your transportation waiting!!!!!!!

## WHAT TO BRING?

1. Pack in one large suitcase, or two small bags. You may have a small carry on for the bus ride. Garmet bags count as a bag! **NO BAND BOX, GUITAR HERO, ANY KIND OF GAMING DEVICE THAT PLUGS INTO A TV. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. On the bus you will want a coat, pillow, toothbrush and other toiletries, snacks, and entertainment. Wear comfortable clothing (layers).
3. Winter clothing needed will include gloves, hats, warm shoes and socks, a full length coat. Dress is generally casual during the day and dressy at night. Buildings tend to be very warm. Layers are the answer, and warm socks!
4. You do not need a lot of cash. Bring \$40-50. If you bring more, use Traveler's Checks or plastic. You must have a photo ID with you. Protect your identity!!
5. We will collect any medicine you may need on the trip. List all medications on your medical form and give to Mrs. Peck.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING?

1. Anything of value that you can't live without-leave at home.
2. If you bring a MP3 player, CD player, DVD, etc. have your name on every piece. Label your CDs with your name.
3. Do not bring videos for the bus. We will have a large selection of approved videos for you to watch. (just deal with this).
4. Do not bring shoes that you cannot comfortably walk a distance wearing.
5. \*Do not bring any drug we do not have in our possession. Tobacco in any form will be very uncool and result in a trip home at your parent's expense and no refund! Alcohol or any other illegal drug-either possession or use-will result in a trip home, no refund, and removal from chorus.
6. No pets.

## RULES FOR THE ROAD

1. **YOU ARE NEVER TO GO ANYWHERE ALONE. EVER. PERIOD. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
2. Always act in a civilized and decent manner, remembering who you are and who you represent.
3. No possession or use of illegal substances-see item 5 above.
4. No contact with anyone outside of our group, except with permission of a director, Dr. Arthur or Mrs. Peck. No contact with people on the street-none.
5. Curfews will be set each night as we arrive at the hotel. Before curfew, do not leave the floors to go to the lobby alone-bring a friend. When in doubt-ask.
6. After curfew no visitation between rooms. The chaperones need some sleep. If you need something-call your "Mom" or "Dad".
7. Protect your valuables. Wear purses across your body and carry wallets in front pockets. Money clips are good. Have a picture ID with you at all times.
8. **AT NO TIME DOES ANYONE GO ANYWHERE ALONE.** A group is defined as 3 or more people. Outside the hotel lobby no one leaves the area with less than 3 people.
9. Carry the Cell-phone list with you or have it entered in your phone. Turn phones off in theatres, but have them on when out and about.
10. If you have an emergency and get separated from the group....**DO NOT CALL ANYONE IN TALLAHASSEE!** They can't help you! Call one of us in NY!! Best idea, don't get lost!

Parents: Please do not ask your student to call home at regular intervals. Most of them have cell phones, but need to have them "off" when we are on tours and in theatres.
