

New York Trip Information – November 16-21, 2023

(Departing Tallahassee at 5pm on 11/16 – returning evening of 11/21)



What: Biennial Trip to New York City for the purpose of seeing as many Broadway shows as we can!

Who: Junior/Senior Members of Capital Singers. Other Chorus, Drama and Technical Theatre students may be invited by Mrs. Peck (Technical Theatre) or Mrs. Marshall (Drama).

How much???? The trip is \$1950 *because this is an elective trip we do not do group fundraisers*

The \$1950 cost of the trip includes:

Bus ~ Hotel ~ Attractions/Tours ~ Shows ~ \$\$ for **every** meal (handed out in cash!)

How do I reserve my place?

Bring a non-refundable deposit of \$500 AND the permission form (attached) **asap**. **The trip is first come, first served**. Cash, Check, or Paypal Payment (go to www.leonchorus.com for the link!) Spot not reserved until the signed permission form is received as well as the payment!

Payment Schedule (all payments are NON-REFUNDABLE)

now until May 15th: \$500 deposit

July 1st: \$375 payment due

August 15th: \$375 payment due

September 15th: \$375 payment due

October 15th: \$325 payment due

FAQ's:

1. Can my student fly up instead of riding the bus?

No. The trip is a group event and all activities are to be participated in as a unit.

2. Can I meet you all in NYC and take my student for a day of fun with me or family we have in the area?

No. The trip is a group event and all activities are to be participated in as a unit. Your family member is welcome to join us at shows/etc. They will need to purchase their own ticket. If they'd like a ticket with our group we need that info and payment by June 1st.

4. Can I be a chaperone? Or – a partial chaperone?

All official chaperones will be Leon County Schools Employees. If a parent would like to chaperone and go on the bus, there are limited seats (the seats go to the students first) available May 16th. The price would be the same as the students and the BUS chaperone would be expected to be at everything the students would be doing. This would require fingerprinting through LCS. Students and "BUS Chaperones" are to remain with the "Leon plan" the entire trip – aka – not be "taken away" to have personal excursions with a parent or family member in the area. If a parent would like to meet us in NYC and just attend shows with us – please secure your own hotel arrangements and let me know which of our shows you'd like to see by June 1st. Payment for all shows requested due by the July 1st student payment date.

5. We have Thanksgiving plans – can my student be transported to the airport?

YES! We can have a LCS adult accompany your student to the airport on Tuesday morning (you'd be paying an extra hotel night -about \$300 for the one night - and cab transport, and we need to coordinate flight times for all departing this way. Your plans would need to be convenient to the "airport adult's" plan)
